## BEGINNER CLASS INFORMATION

1. Beginner Obedience Class Session will consist of 8 weeks of instruction including Orientation on the first night of class. Class days are Tuesday or Thursday, both at 6:30pm
2. Classes are held at Twin Ports Dog Training Club at 5092 Lindahl Road, Duluth, MN, 55811. Directions as follows: Head up Hwy #53 for 5 ½ miles north of Target to the junction of Hwy #53 and Hwy 194. At the junction, turn right (north) on the Lindahl Road for 2 ½ miles, you will cross over Martin Rd. The Training Center is on the right side of the road.
3. Dogs do not need to be purebred or AKC registered to qualify for class training. AKC now registers "All American Dogs" for companion events. Please check their website for details: [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org).
4. Minimum age requirement of dog in class is 5 months.
5. Minimum age requirement for handlers is 12 years and must be physically able to control the dog.
6. Only ONE PERSON is permitted to handle (train) dog during class instruction for the ENTIRE SESSION. The person handling the dog must be the one to sign the release form. Parent/Guardian must also sign for children between 12 and 18.
7. All handlers will be required to present proof of current Rabies and Distemper vaccination. Rabies tags are not accepted as valid proof.
8. No female dogs in season may be brought to class. Beginning handlers should plan to attend class during this time and continue to work with their dog at home.
9. Beginner Class Fee is \$100.00. Fee must be paid in full prior to the start of the session. No refund of class fees can be made after orientation night except in specific cases, as determined by the Board of Directors of Twin Ports Dog Training Club.
10. To reserve a place in class, the fee must be returned with application and release. Pre-registration is preferred. All others will be accepted on Orientation Night on a first come basis if the class has not yet been filled.
11. The Director of Training and the Assistant Director reserve the right to expel any uncontrollable dogs from class. The fee is refunded for any expelled dog.
12. Please do not park on the road or in entrances/exits. There is ample parking in the parking lot. Please observe entrance and exit signs. People and dogs are coming and going at all times when classes are in session.

Please complete the application and return 10 days prior to class date with a release signed by the person handling the dog in class, copy of current shot records and the fee.
